Dear Madame or Sir,

SCIP is the database for information on **S**ubstances of **C**oncern **I**n articles as such or in complex objects (**P**roducts) established under the Waste Framework Directive (WFD) 2008/98/EC. This database has been set up and is being maintained by the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA). Companies supplying articles on the EU market containing substances of very high concern (SVHCs) on the Candidate List in a concentration above 0.1% weight by weight (w/w) must submit information on these articles to ECHA, effective 5 January 2021.

HUBER+SUHNER will ensure that the information on articles containing substances on the Candidate List above the threshold concentration will be available throughout the entire lifecycle of these articles. Therefore, HUBER+SUHNER intends to implement an automated data transfer to the SCIP database by applying a system-to-system service (S2S) which requires extensive adjustments to the company's ERP systems. Due to the complexity of this global project on the part of HUBER+SUHNER, the implementation of the S2S cannot be completed before the end of 2023. As the articles concerned have a service life of up to 20 years or longer, safe handling at the end of their service life and safe recycling of the materials is ensured despite the delayed submission of the required product information.
